  - 4.1 Budget
    - We were 76 kids short of the projection- 629 students of the 705 projected
    - \$300,000 in the negative
      - \$50,000 carry over from last year
      - \$76,700 in attrition money
      - \$10,000 in service level agreements that aren't used
      - No humanities = \$85,000

- We will surplus 2 teachers- one in kinder and one in third
- Budget left is \$111,000 to run the building for the remainder of the year
- Building needs: \$35,000 for the remainder of the math program, \$4,000 for ST Math, \$9,000 for Lexia, \$1,000 for Reading A-Z.
  - \$10 charge for chromebooks goes to account to cover software and repairs/replacements.
  - Pizza money goes into SGF for student of the month, ST math parties, etc.
     September brought in about \$1,200.
- We need to try and roll over about \$25,000 into next year. Projected shortfall of \$17 million next year.

## 4.2 Staffing

- Loss of resource teacher- Jared Owens to move to Autism, Ms. Fagan to do resource K-5
- One hour added to Ronnie in the front office- she will have 2 hours a day to push into classrooms to help provide IEP minutes

## 4.3 Attendance

- Chronic absenteeism down to 10.4% from 15.1%. Good decrease
  - O What can we do to help bring it down to about 8%?
